**Do you want to keep your eyes healthy? Do you want to protect your children's eyesight from early on?**

As an optometrist for 20 years, I've had the opportunity to see many of the conditions I'm going to talk about in this presentation. I will be showing what the ocular pathologies look like and will be discussing how they affect the eye and how they are treated. After this presentation, I hope you understand that many ocular conditions, from minor to severe, have similar appearances, but can have significantly different outcomes, especially if not treated properly. The eye is a wondrous organ and we at Alcon are doing everything in our power to help preserve and protect sight.



**Dr. Mike Christensen** is currently an Associate Director of Dry Eye Clinical Research at Alcon Laboratories, Inc and Director of Alcon's in-house Research Clinic. He received his O.D. degree at Northeastern State University Oklahoma College of Optometry in 1989 and joined Alcon in 1990 as a Research Optometrist. Dr. Christensen's research has focused primarily in Consumer Products and over the years has worked with both Contact Lens Care and Dry Eye products.
